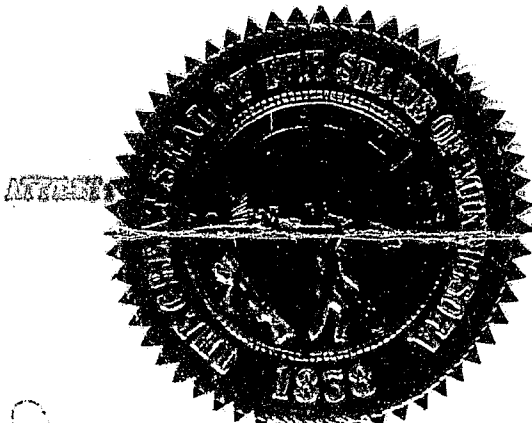
WHEREAS, this association will set aside the week of September 24th to October 3rd, to note the anniversary of their founding;

WHEREAS, this association will celebrate the week of September 21st to October 3rd, to note the anniversary of their founding;

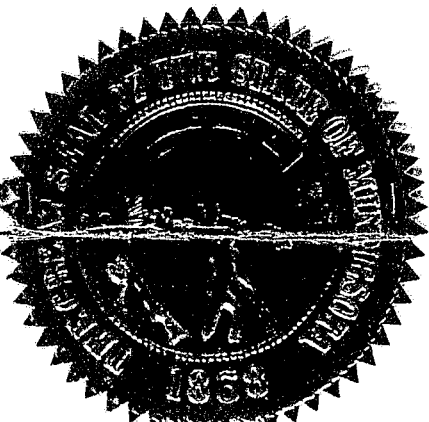
