NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 15 - 21, 1956 as


NATIONAL BIBLE WEEK

and urge all Minnesotans to partake again of the enlightening message for all people contained in the Holy Bible.


