A Proclamation for "Air Defense Day"

- WHEREAS, an Air Defense Pageant is proposed to be staged by the command and personnel of Duluth Air Base, home of the first combat ready Supersonic All-Weather Interceptor Squadron in the United States; and
- WHEREAS, said Air Defense Pageant is to be held Saturday and Sunday, October 27 and 28, 1956; and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of said Air Defense Pageant is to present to the public the story of fighter-type aircraft of World War I to the supersonic F-102A All-Weather Interceptors of today;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby determine that said Pageant is of sufficient public interest to warrant the declaration of the said day as Sunday, October 28, 1956, as

"AIR DEFENSE DAY"

and urge all persons to attend said Pageant.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six and of the State, the ninety-ninth.
