PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF SILVER BAY

KNOW, The undersigned are the persons who signed the "PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF SILVER BAY" dated September 13, 1956, and,

KNOW, The said petition was based upon a census taken by Robert L. Wigor, Mary T. Bonar, and Ruth G. Wigor between the dates of August 20, 1956, and September 13, 1956, and,

KNOW, Through a clerical error, the said census did not set forth a correct figure for the total population of the territory described in the foregoing petition and,

KNOW, Based upon the census as originally prepared and filed, the undersigned prepared and signed their petition above mentioned, stating the resident population of the area to be 3,160 persons and,

KNOW, The said Robert L. Wigor, Mary T. Bonar, and Ruth G. Wigor have now executed a statement to their said census, disclosing the total population of the said area as of the date of taking the said census, September 13, 1956, to have been 3,176.

NOW THEREFORE, THE undersigned, for the purposes of removing a clerical error in the preparation of the "Petition for Incorporation of Silver Bay" dated September 13, 1956, and conforming the said petition to the facts, do hereby amend paragraph 6 of the said petition to read as follows:

"6. The foregoing lands, both platted and unplatte, and bounded as described, contain a resident population of 3,176 persons, as ascertained by a census which was conducted on the 20th day of August, 1956, and completed on the 13th day of September, 1956, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof."

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Lake, Minnesota:

We, the undersigned, residents of the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your Board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters within said territory may vote on the question of incorporating the same as a village, and for that purpose respectfully state:

1. All of your petitioners are qualified voters and residents within the territory hereinafter described, and each has resided continuously within said territory for at least two years prior to the date of this petition.
2. None of the territory hereinafter described is now a part of any incorporated city or village.
3. The territory which is proposed to incorporate consists partly of land which have been platted into lots and streets, which lots have been duly and legally recorded and certified according to the laws of this state and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of the County of Lake, Minnesota, and partly of unplatetd land which adjoin the platted areas and are so conditioned as properly to be sublated to village government. All of said land, platted and unplatetd, lie entirely within the Survey of Lake, Minnesota, and the description of said lands, both platted and unplatetd is as follows:

The Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (1/4 of 1/4) of Section Twenty-nine (29), all of Section Twenty-nine (29), all of Section Thirty (30), all of Section Thirtynine (31) and all of Section Thirty-two (32), all being situated in Township Forty-five (45) North of Range Seven (7) West, and

All of Section Five (5), all of Section Six (6) and all of land in Township Seven (7), all being situated in Township Forty-five (45) North of Range Seven (7) West, and

The East one-half (1/2) of Section Twenty-five (25), the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (1/4 of 1/4) of Section Twenty-five (25), the East one-half of the Southwest Quarter (1/2 of 1/4) of Section Twenty-five (25), and all of Section Thirty-five (35), all being situated in Township Fifty-six (56) North of Range Eight (8) West, and

The East one-half (1/2) of Section One (1) and the North one-half of the Northwest Quarter (1/4 of 1/4) of Section Two (2), all being situated in Township Fifty-five (55) North of Range Seven (7) West, and

Including the following described platted areas:

1. Silver Bay, First Division
2. Silver Bay, Second Division
3. Silver Bay, Third Division
4. First Reservation River Reserve (12)

5. Silver Bay, Fourth Division

6. Silver Bay, Fifth Division

7. Silver Bay, Sixth Division

All of which are a part of the above described property as two fully opposite  
parts Exhibit #1 attached.

Property intending to include Beaver Island, Pollet Island, all break-  
waters, piers, revetments, dock and harbor within the confines of such waters  
and bounds and containing four thousand two hundred (4,200) acres, more or  
less,

All being situated in the Town of Silver Bay, County of Lake and the  
State of Minnesota.

h. The boundaries of the foregoing lands are as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the South Line of Section  
Sixty (6), Township Fifty-five (55) North, Range Seven (7) West of the Fourth  
(4th) Principal Meridian and the shore of Lake Superior, which point is the  
point of beginning, proceed in a southerly direction to the next South-  
westerly point of Pollet Island, located in Section Seven (7), Township  
Fifty-five (55) North, Range Seven (7) West; thence proceed in a north-  
easterly direction from said line at a distance great enough to intercept

of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Fifty-six (56) North, Range Eight (8)  
West; thence proceed South along the South Line (4) of said Section Twenty-  
two (22) to the Northwest (NW) corner of the Southwest Quarter of the North-  
west Quarter (NW of NW) of said Section Twenty-two (22); thence proceed  
West along the North Line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter  
(NW of NW) of said Section Twenty-two (22) to the West quadrant, (1/4)  
line of said Section Twenty-two (22); thence proceed South along the West  
quadrant, (1/4) line of said Section Twenty-two (22) to the North Line of  
Section Thirteen (13), Township Fifty-six (56) North, Range Eight (8) West;  
thence proceed West along the North Line of said Section Thirteen (13) to  
the Northwest corner thereof; thence proceed South to the Southwest, (SW)  
corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW of NW) of  
Section One (1), Township Fifty-five North, (55), Range Eight (8) West; thence  
proceed East to the North-South Quarter (NS) line of said Section one (1);  
thence proceed South along said Quarter line to the North corner (NW) corner  
of said Section One (1); thence proceed East to the place of beginning, as  
hereinafter appears from Exhibit #1 attached.

5. The quantity of land, both platted and unplatte, covered within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is four thousand two hundred (4,200) acres, to the date now or 1956.
  6. The Populating land, both platted and unplatte, and bounded as described, contains a resident population of 3,180 persons, as ascertained by a census which was commenced on the 20th day of August, 1956, and completed on the 13th day of September, 1956, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
  7. The name of the village proposed to be incorporated is the Village of Silver Bay, Minnesota.
  8. Your petitioners also request that at the same election at the same time and place the following question be submitted to the qualified voters residing within said territory:

"Shall Standard Plan A, specifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village if the village is incorporated?"



## SKETCH


Showing area proposed for incorporation of Silver Bay outlined in heavy black line and showing some features to serve as a guide. Area contains 4200 acres, more or less.
