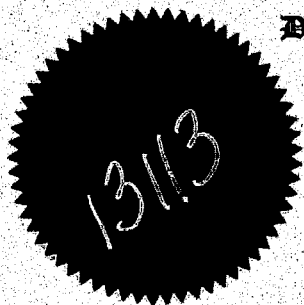
To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

I Certify That, satisfactory evidence having been exhibited of the appointment of
Aage Frederik Røthner as Vice Consul of Norway at Minneapolis,
Minnesota, the President of the United States of America has ordered
his recognition as such officer, declaring him free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers, and
privileges as are allowed to the Vice Consuls of the most favored Nations in the United States.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Herbert Hoover, Jr., Acting Secretary of State
of the United States of America, have hereunto subscribed my name and caused the Seal of the
Department of State to be affixed.

Done at the City of Washington this eight day of October, in the year
of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, and the 181st year
of the Independence of the United States of America.
