Enclosed are the results of our Annual Village Election of December 4, 1956, after the Official Canvass, December 5, 1956.

By Official ballot it was determined that the Village of Iron Jct. shall not issue intoxicating liquor licenses, the vote being 45 against and 26 for license.

By Advisory ballot it was determined that the Village of Iron Jct. should not issue non-intoxicating liquor licenses, the vote being 40 against and 30 for license.

Both questions were put to the vote of the electorate as a result of two petitions, signed each by twelve legal voters of the Village of Iron Jct.
