

ORDINANCE NO. 39

ORDINANCE DETACHING LAND
FROM THE VILLAGE OF HAN-
COCK, MINNESOTA

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HANCOCK, MINNESOTA DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described tracts of land located
within the corporate limits of the Village of Hancock, Minnesota, viz:

Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Three (3) and the East
half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Ten (10),
all in Township One twenty-three (123) North, Range Forty
one (41) West

be detached from the Village of Hancock, Minnesota and attached to and
become a part of the Township of Moore.

Section 2. That said tracts of land be subject to taxation for
the payment of interest and principal on all Village bonded indebtedness
outstanding at this time.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from
and after its passage and publication and filing as provided by law.
