EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the Library Service Act, Public Law 597, passed by the Congress in June, 1956, makes funds available for the development of state library services in Minnesota to the amount of \$40,000.00 for this fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Education at its regular meeting passed a resolution recommending that the Governor of the State of Minnesota accept for and in the name of the State of Minnesota the funds made available for library services under Public Law 597, Library Services Act; and


WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes 1953, section 120.36 provides that in the event of the passage of such legislation and upon the recommendation of the State Board of Education, at a time when the legislature is not in session, the Governor shall accept the provisions of such act by executive order, pending further action by the legislature;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to the above Minnesota law, do hereby accept the provisions of Public Law 597, as to funds available to Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, and of the state, the ninety-ninth.
