KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, MILES LORD,
Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the
authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by
authority of Minnesota Statutes 1953, Sec. 8.06, do hereby
on request of the Minnesota State Agricultural Society, con-
stitute and appoint PHILLIP NEVILLE, of Minneapolis, Minnesota,
as Special Assistant Attorney General to act for the said
Minnesota State Agricultural Society.

This appointment is made upon recommendation of the
Governing Board of the Minnesota State Fair, and his compensation
therefor shall be paid out of funds of the Minnesota State Agri-
cultural Society upon verified claims therefor presented to said
Society by the appointee. His compensation is hereby fixed at the
sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day for services rendered.
The compensation so fixed shall continue until otherwise determined.
Said appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General
or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated
in accordance with law.


