Recommendation for Minnesota Dental Health Day

WHEREAS, health day is the most powerful, the most complete and the most costly element of children and youth and

WHEREAS, dental health is a reflection of the care given the teeth in early life and

WHEREAS, prevention of dental disease in children through early and continued oral care is the most practical defense for the protecting the dental health of the public and

WHEREAS, the content of the Minnesota Dental Society are also working into extensive dental health education and dental care for children in the interest of better health;

AND WHEREAS, I, Willis L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 3 through 9, 1954 as

MINNESOTA DENTAL HEALTH WEEK

and urge all Minnesotans to cooperate with this program.

BY COMMAND OF THE GOVERNOR, I designate and by joint act accept the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this third day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four and of the State, the ninety-eighth.
