To all whom it may concern:

Satisfactory evidence having been exhibited to me
that Jokas Bragovic
has been appointed Consul General of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia at
Chicago, Illinois for the States of Arkansas, Florida, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas, and Wisconsin.
I do hereby recognize him as such, and declare him free to exercise and enjoy such
functions, powers and privileges as are allowed to the Consuls General of the most favored
Nations in the United States.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the
United States to be hereunto affixed.

Done at the City of Washington this thirtieth day of October
in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty six, and of the
Independence of the United States of America the one hundred and eighty first.
