Memorandum for the Director, Agricultural Administration

1. To determine, as in all parts of the United States, the general, progressive, and in particular, the special and agricultural conditions are shown that have place in our country and world today and

2. The conditions are only now that all citizens, whether directly involved in agricultural life or in the home and life family or only indirectly benefiting from the work of the farm, recognized the spiritual and cultural opportunities to be realized in country living and the land use family program for the well-being of the farm family, as well as will not waste opportunities for the benefit of the people through study and

3. The National Catholic Rural Life Conference and other groups a similar program to guide in the Department of Agriculture, of the United States to be held in intelligent and effective rural living

4. The Secretary of State, United States Department of the State of Missouri, or other persons for the year 1937 - 1938, 1939

RECOMMENDATION

and will give all Americans to join in the promotion of the well-being of the Department of our rural country and of the people who live on the land in it.

As a result of this study, I recommend that the Department of Agriculture be authorized to hold and conduct the first year of the National Catholic Rural Life Conference in the State of Missouri to be held in the State Capital Building, South City of St. Louis in the year 1937 and that the Department of Agriculture be authorized to hold and conduct the second and subsequent years of the conference in other parts of the State, as appropriate.
