



WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, 1953, Section 12.021, Sub-division 5, provides that land not located in an incorporated municipality containing a resident population of not less than 75 persons and no part of which land is more than  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles from the village limits, may be annexed to an adjoining village upon petition of five or more legal voters of the area by filing with the Village Clerk of such village a petition requesting an election on the question of including such land in the village; and

WHEREAS, the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 22 West abuts upon the North boundary of the Village of Little Canada and is not located in an incorporated municipality, and contains a population of more than 75 persons; and

WHEREAS, the territory within the said South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 22 West is an area so conditioned as to be properly subjected to village government,

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned, being legal voters residing within the South one-half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 22 West, which said half-section lies within  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles of the Village of Little Canada, is adjacent to the North boundary of said Village of Little Canada, is not within an incorporated area and contains a resident population of 124 persons, do hereby respectfully petition the Village Council of the Village of Little Canada to annex to the said Village of Little Canada the said South one-half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 22 West, Ramsey County, and we request an election on the question of incorporating the said area into the said Village of Little Canada.

We do further represent, by means of this petition, that we, the undersigned, have taken a census of the above described area

as indicated on the census report hereto attached and made a part of this petition.





WADEAU, Clerk of the Village of Little Canada, do hereby certify that the following resolutions were duly adopted at a special meeting of the Council of the Village of Little Canada, held at the regular meeting place at the Fire Hall of the Village of Little Canada, on Thursday, February 21, 1957, at 6:30 P.M., and that said resolutions are set forth here fully and correctly as they appear in the minutes of the Village of Little Canada for said meeting:

"RESOLVED, That the petition presented to the Village of Little Canada for the annexation of the South one-half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 22 West, as presented by Henry J. Monn, Joseph F. Fletcher, Richard H. Jacobsen, Libero Morri and Richard A. Bertrand, legal voters and residents of said half section, which petition has been examined and approved by the Village Attorney, be and is hereby accepted by the Council of the said Village of Little Canada and the Village Council hereby approves said request for annexation on the grounds that the area to be annexed is a territory abutting upon the Village of Little Canada, is not included in any other village, city or borough, and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government."

"RESOLVED, That the 9th day of March, 1957, be and is hereby designated as the date upon which the legal voters of the South one-half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 22 West, vote on the question of annexation of said area to the Village of Little Canada; that the polls be open on said date from 3:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.; that said election be held at the Little Canada Fire Hall, 440 E. Little Canada Road in the Village of Little Canada; that the Clerk be and is hereby instructed to post notices pursuant to law at three (3) different places within the said South one-half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section 31 notifying the legal voters of that area of the place, time and date of said election, and that Henry Monn, Richard Jacobsen and A. R. Mitchell, legal voters and residents of the above described area, be and are hereby designated as judges for the purpose of conducting said election."




