A Resolution for the Recognition of the Eastern

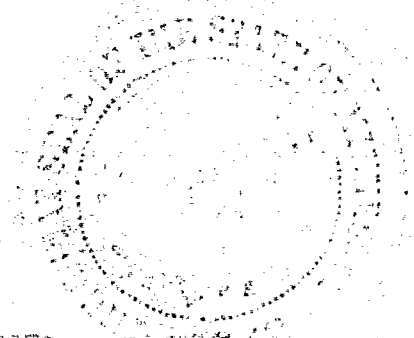
Orthodox Church

- WHEREAS, the Eastern Orthodox Church is a sister faith throughout the United States and throughout the State of Minnesota;
- WHEREAS, this body gives all members of the Eastern Orthodox Church in and out of the State the same rights and privileges which they enjoy in the State of Minnesota, Massachusetts and Iowa;
- WHEREAS, this body recognizes with these members with full parity for the purpose of law, their organizations and their activities, and their recognition equal to that accorded other such faiths;

BEFORE ME, Joseph L. Norman, Secretary of the State of Minnesota, having to do with the same, and a Commission of the Minnesota Legislature of 1931, passed on February 23, 1931, do hereby give the recognition of the

as a sister faith and will give all citizens and officials of power and in the State of Minnesota to such members of this faith in official duty, construction and other matters.
