WHEREAS, the Eastern Orthodox Church is a major faith throughout the United States and throughout the State of Minnesota;

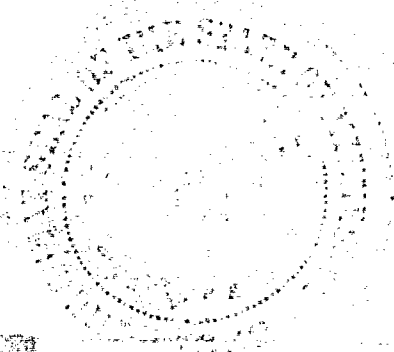
WHEREAS, this body, every member of the Eastern Orthodox Church is most often entitled from official publications and publications which list only the names of churches, parishes and monasteries;
