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PETITION FOR THE INCORPORATION OF TWIN LAKES

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Freeborn County, Minnesota:

The undersigned, 61 voters, residents of the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your honorable board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote on the proposition of incorporating such territory as a village to be known by the name of Twin Lakes. The territory proposed to be incorporated is described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 101 North, Range 22 West, Freeborn County, Minnesota, thence West to the northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11, said township and range; thence south to the southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 11; thence East to the southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 12; thence North to the point of beginning,

Also that certain tract of land commencing on the West side of the Public Highway at the point nearest the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 14, Township 101, Range 22, running thence West along the section line 655 feet, thence due south 200 feet, thence East parallel with said section line to the public highway, thence along the West side of said public highway in a Northeasterly direction to the point of beginning.
