




CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION RESULTS

To the Auditor of Freeborn County, Minnesota:

This is to certify that an election was held at the school house in Twin Lakes, Freeborn County, Minnesota, pursuant to resolution of the Honorable Board of County Supervisors, Freeborn County, Minnesota, said resolution being dated March 5, 1957. The election was held on April 2, 1957. The polls were open from 1:00 p. m. o'clock until 8:30 p.m. o'clock on said day.

The undersigned, duly appointed judges of said election, canvassed the ballots cast and hereby certify that there were 73 votes cast. That of said 73 votes case there were 72 votes in favor of incorporating said territory to be known as Twin Lakes. There were no ballots cast against incorporating and there was one ballot which in the opinion of the judges was spoiled and not taken into account.

RESOLUTION

Introduced by Reindal

WHEREAS, a petition for the incorporation of a village to be known as Twin Lakes has been presented to this board; which petition is signed by 61 voters and residents of the proposed village territory to be known as Twin Lakes, asking the board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote upon the proposition of incorporating the territory described in said petition; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board that said petition is in the form required by statute and signed by the requisite number of persons residing within such proposed territory; and that a census has been taken of the residents within said territory showing the required number of residents in said area, as required by law, which census is attached to said petition;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that an election be held on the 2nd day of April, 1957, in the village territory to be known as Twin Lakes, in the School House situate within said proposed village territory. The polls shall be open from 1:00 o'clock until 8:30 o'clock p.m. on said day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following persons, electors within said territory, be and hereby are appointed judges of said election: Leo Donahue, Melvin Overland, F. L. White

PETITION FOR THE INCORPORATION OF TWIN LAKES

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Freeborn County,
Minnesota:

The undersigned, 61 voters, residents of the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your honorable board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote on the proposition of incorporating such territory as a village to be known by the name of Twin Lakes. The territory proposed to be incorporated is described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 101 North, Range 22 West, Freeborn County, Minnesota, thence West to the northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11, said township and range; thence south to the southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 11; thence East to the southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 12; thence North to the point of beginning,

Also that certain tract of land commencing on the West side of the Public Highway at the point nearest the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 14, Township 101, Range 22, running thence West along the section line 655 feet, thence due south 200 feet, thence East parallel with said section line to the public highway, thence along the West side of said public highway in a Northeasterly direction to the point of beginning.

Part of the territory consists of lands which have been platted into lots and blocks, which plat has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this state and has been filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Freeborn County, the county in which said lands lie, and the unplatted part of such territory adjoins the platted portion and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government. Such territory contains approximately 323 acres of land and has 147 actual residents thereon, as has been duly ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the 27th, day of February, 1957, as appears by the verification attached hereto. The undersigned have resided continuously within said territory proposed to be incorporated for at least two (2) years prior to the date of this petition.
