Ehorons, a statement by the State Conservation Committee, accompanying the above mentioned application, has been filed in this office, setting forth that a petition for the creation of the Marshall County Seil Conservation District was filed with the State Seil Conservation Committee; that, after due notice, a hearing was held, and the committee duly determined that there is need, in the interest of public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory, and that the Committee defined the boundaries thereof; that then, after due notice, a referendum was held on the question of the creation of said district, and the results of said referendum showed a majority of the votes cast to be in fever of the creation of said district; and that thereafter the Committee duly determined that the operation of the proposed district is administratively practicable and feesible. Said referendum also set forth the boundaries of the castilet as defined by the State Committee.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PURSELVES SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

Be it known that on the 28th day of January, 1957, a petition for the organization of the Marshall County Soil Conservation District, signed by more than twenty-five land occupiers was duly filed in the office of the State Soil Conservation Committee;

That on the 14th and 15th days of February, 1957, at Argyle and Heufolden, a public hearing was held after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

What on the 25th day of February, 1957, the State Soil Concervation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory and did define the boundaries thereof;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of the creation of the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the defined boundaries on the 20th day of March, 1957;

That the result of the referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the seid referendum were in favor of the creation of the said district;

That thereafter on the 25th day of March, 1957, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that the operation of the said district is administratively practicable and feasible;

That the boundaries of the said district were defined by the State Soil Conservation Committee as follows:

All of the townships of Eagle Point, Donnelly, Sinnott, Augsburg, Boxville, Welson Park, Lincoln, East Park, Huntly, Como, Fork, Parker, Tamarac, Wanger, Wright, West Valley, New Maine, Spruce Valley, Cedar, Big Woods, Bloomer, Middle River, Alma, Foldahl, Marsh Grove, Newfolden, Holt, East Valley, Oak Park, Vega, Warrenton, McCrea, Comstock, Viking, New Solum, and Excel, in the county of Marshall, Minnesota.

There shall be exempted from the area bounded by the above described boundaries all lands used exclusively for religious, school or burial purposes.
