RESOLUTION

That the said description erroneously refers to Range 20 West, although in fact no part of the Township of Mounds View lies within Range 20 West, but all of the Township of Mounds View and all of the property sought to be annexed by this Petition is actually within Range 23 West. That a public hearing was held by this Council at the Village Hall of April 1, 1957, at which time a substantial number of residents of the territory sought to be annexed appeared; that at said time the area concerned was pointed out on a map of Mounds View Township, and the area thus pointed out was the area in the Township of Mounds View, Range 23 West, which lies within one and one-half miles of the westerly limits of the Village of Arden Hills in the said Sections 28 and 33. That following said meeting a Notice of Election on said matter was posted at three of the most public places within the area in the Township of Mounds View, Range 23 West, sought to be annexed; that following said

posting and prior to said Election several public meetings were held in said area for the purpose of explaining the proposed annexation and that this Council is well satisfied that there was no confusion by reason of the inadvertent misdescription of the property affected, ^{and} that none of the residents of the territory sought to be annexed were actually confused or misled thereby.
