A Proclamation for "Miss Minnesota Days"

WHEREAS, each year a Miss America is chosen in the United States, on the basis of talent, charm and beauty and a scholarship for the furtherance of the education of the young woman selected is provided; and

WHEREAS, in preparation for this event in 1957, various communities throughout Minnesota have held local pageants of beauty at which young ladies have been chosen to represent these communities in the Miss Minnesota Pageant, sponsored by the Minnesota Junior Chamber of Commerce, at which Miss Minnesota will be selected; and

WHEREAS, the holding of a statewide contest to select a Miss Minnesota at Albert Lea, Minnesota will make it possible for a representative of this state to take part in the Miss America pageant at Atlantic City, New Jersey;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 11th and 12th, 1957 as


MISS MINNESOTA DAYS


