WHEREAS, the contributions to the time-saving and coordination modern events schedule have forced our to participate more actively in church, community, and school competition; and


WHEREAS, through organized relay teams, which have also contributed much to our enjoyment of life, we have made our country's men, women and children stronger and healthier;


