A Proclamation for Cerebral Palsy Month

WHEREAS, It has been definitely established that Cerebral Palsy is not the hopeless condition it once was considered, and that a majority of those affected can be materially improved; and

WHEREAS, excellent progress has been made during the past seven years by United Cerebral Palsy in its vigorous nation-wide attack upon every phase of this crippling ailment, and it is sound policy to foster efforts designed to improve public health and general welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1957 as

UNITED CEREBRAL PALSY MONTH

in Minnesota and urge that the citizens of this state accord the appeal of United Cerebral Palsy their generous and enthusiastic support.
