
The issue to be voted upon is: Shall the following territory be annexed to the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota:

"Commencing at a point on the Center Line of Birch Lake Boulevard North, which is thirty-three (33) feet South of the Southwest corner of Lot Fifteen (15), Block Eight (8), Interlake Park Plat 1, and the present limits of the City of White Bear Lake; running thence Westerly along the center line of Birch Lake Boulevard North to the point where it intersects with the center line of Centerville Road; thence running Southerly along the center line of Centerville Road to a point where it intersects with the center line of Birch Lake Boulevard South; thence running in a Northeasterly direction along the center line of Birch Lake Boulevard South to a point where it intersects with the center line of Trunk Highway 96; thence Easterly along the center line of Trunk Highway 96 to a point five hundred, sixty-six (566) feet East of the point of intersection of the center line of Otter Lake Road with Trunk Highway 96; thence running in a Northerly direction along a line to the point of beginning, which is approximately five hundred, sixty-six (566) feet East of the point of intersection with Birch Lake Boulevard North and Otter Lake Road".

The aforesaid territory contains approximately 480 acres of land.



RESOLUTION NO. 82

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT AN ELECTION BE HELD ON THE QUESTION
OF ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORIES TO THE CITY OF WHITE BEAR LAKE, MINN.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated the 12th day of April, 1957, requesting that an election be held on the question of annexing certain territory described therein to the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, was duly presented to this Council on the 9th day of May, 1957, and

WHEREAS, said petition is in proper form and it appears therefrom that the same was signed by the required number of legal voters and that the territory therein described contains 231 persons and is within one and one half miles of this City Limit; and

WHEREAS, the territory proposed to be annexed is properly to be subjected to City Government; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that annexation would be to the best interests of the City and of the territory to be annexed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of White Bear Lake, Ramsey County, Minnesota:

That an election is hereby called and directed to be held on the 25th day of May, 1957, at the Neil Franey Garage, 1323 Hedmanway at which election all qualified voters residing within the territory described in said petition may vote for or against the annexation of said territory to the City of White Bear Lake; and the polls at said election shall be open from 7:00 A.M. o'clock until 8:00 P.M. o'clock of said day.

1. Mrs. Neil Franey, 1323 Hedmanway, Carroll Koeplinger, 1324 Hedmanway and Carl Edstrom, 1311 Hedmanway, all residing within said territory, are hereby appointed to be Judges of said election, and the Judges of said election shall conduct the election so far as is practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of City Officers.
2. That the City Clerk shall cause notice of said election to be given in the manner prescribed by law.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilman Podvin, and on his motion, supported by Councilman Tomaszewski, was declared carried on the following vote:

TO THE CITY OF WHITE BEAR LAKE:

We, the undersigned, residents and legal voters of the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your council and request that you order an election on the question of annexing the territory hereinafter described, to the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota.

We further petition that your council fix a time and place where said election shall be held.

I

That all of your petitioners are legal voters and residents of the territory hereinafter described.

II

That none of the territory hereinafter described is now a part of any incorporated city or village.

III

That the territory, which it is proposed to annex, contains a resident population of more than 75 persons and no part of the land is more than one and one-half miles from the City limits of the City of White Bear Lake.

IV

All of said territory lies entirely within the County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota, and is described as follows:
