NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1957, as


SENIOR CITIZENS MONTH

and urge all citizens to cooperate with the programs carried on this month in honor of our older citizens.


