A Proclamation for "Flag Day in Minnesota"

WHEREAS, it is important, in these troubled times when many people throughout the world are suffering under conditions of misery and economic and spiritual want, that we who are blessed with God's abundance in the United States, hold high the values which make our enjoyment of life possible; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon every man, woman and child in Minnesota and in the nation to reverent and hold in high esteem the emblem of the nation in which we live; and

WHEREAS, each year a day is set aside for the special honoring of our national flag;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the day of June 9, 1957, as


FLAG DAY

and urge Minnesota citizens to display and honor the flag of the United States on this day.


