PETITION

To the Village Council, Village of New Brighton, State of Minnesota

The undersigned hereby propose the annexation to the Village of New Brighton of the following territory, situated in the Township of Moundview, County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota, described as follows:

That land of Moundview Township that lies west of Cleveland Avenue, north of the County Road "D", east of Silver Lake Road and south of the present south boundary limits of the Village of New Brighton, except that land which lies in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 30, Range 23, County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota.

Described otherwise as the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31 and W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 32 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32. All of these above Sections lie in Township 30, Range 23, County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota.

The undersigned represent as follows:

They are voters who reside in the area above described, and owners of property in the area above described. The area described contains approximately 640 acres. No part of the area described is more than one and one-half miles from present Village limits of the Village of New Brighton.

A census of the resident population of the said area was accurately taken commencing April 3, 1957 and ending April 6, 1957, and the number of actual residents in the said area is 233. Attached hereto and marked Exhibit A and hereby made a part hereof is a list prepared from the data submitted by the persons who took the census. Said list shows the location of all residential buildings in the area by street address and the number of persons resident in each building.

Your petitioners believe that it is to the best interests of the Village and of the area described that said area be annexed to the Village of New Brighton, State of Minnesota.

TO THE VOTERS OF THE TERRITORY LYING WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNDS VIEW, COUNTY OF RAMSEY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, Described below as follows, to-wit:

The Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-one (31), the West one-half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Thirty-two (32) and the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-two (32), all lying in Township Thirty (30), Range Twenty-Three (23), County of Ramsey State of Minnesota, otherwise described as that portion of Mounds View Township lying West of Cleveland Avenue, North of County Road "D", East of Silver Lake Road and contiguous to and lying South of the South boundry of the Village of New Brighton, except that land lying in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Thirty (30), Range Twenty-three (23), County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota

Pletscher, Jr. residence located at 3291 Highway No. 8, pursuant to the following resolution of the Council of the Village New Brighton:

BE IT RESOLVED that the petition for annexation filed with the Clerk April 10, 1957 appearing to this Council to be legally sufficient, and it sufficiently appearing to the Council that the annexation would be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected, an election on annexation of the territory described in said petition shall be held at the garage of the John N. Pletscher Jr. residence, 3291 Highway No. 8 on May 10, 1957 between the hours of 2:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M., all pursuant to the Statute in such cases made and provided.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ten (10) days posted notice of such election shall be given commencing April 30, 1957 with notices to be posted at three of the most public places within said territory; and that Gerald Olson, John N. Pletscher, Sr. and Leslie Brost, residents of the territory described shall be appointed as judges for the election; that the ballots and election supplies shall be furnished by the Village in accordance with the Statute, at which election the following question shall be submitted for a vote by ballot, to-wit:


CERTIFICATE OF POSTING ELECTION NOTICES
