His compensation at the rate hereinafter specified shall be paid out of the funds appropriated for the purposes provided in Minnesota Statutes 1953, Sec. 298.22, and is hereby fixed at Five Hundred Twenty Five and No/100 Dollars (\$525.00) per month for such part time as the Commissioner shall require.




