TO ALL TO LEON THESE PALSENTS SHALL COME, GREATING:

HEREAS, Gerhard Hoge, of Altkin, Hinnosota, and William Alenen, of Tamarack, Hinnosota, the duly appointed supervisors of the Aitkin Genty Soil Conservation District, acting pursuant to the Hinnosota Soil Conservation Districts Low, Laws of Minnosota 1937, Chapter 141, approved April 26, 1937, and Laws of Hinnosota 1943, Chapter 274, approved April 2, 1943, have filed in this office an application subscribed and sworn to by each of them before an afficer authorized by law to take and certify eaths, sotting forths: (1) That a potition for the creation of the district was filed with the State Soil Conservation Committee, pursuant to the provisions of the State Soil Conservation Districts Law, and the proceedings specified in soid Act were taken pursuant to such potition, that said application was filed in order to complete the organization of the district as a governmental subscript to the organization of the district as a governmental subscription and public body, corporate and politic and that the State Constitute has appointed them as supervisors, (2) The name and official residence of the district supervisors, together with a cortified copy of the appointments evidencing their right to office; (3) Their term of office; (4) The name which is proposed for the district; and (5) The location and principal office of the Supervisors of the district; and

whereas, a statement by the State Conservation Consisted, accompanying the above mentioned application, has been filed in this office, setting furth that a potition for the creation of the Aithin Gennty Soil Conservation District was filed with the State Soil Conservation Consisted, that, after due notice a hooring was held, and the consisted duly determined that there is need, in the interest of public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory, and that the Consisted defined the boundaries thereof; that then, after due notice, a referendum was held on the question of the creation of said district, and the results of said referendum showed a majority of the votes cost to be in favor of the creation of said district; and that thereofter the Committee duly determined that the operation of the proposed district is administratively practicable and feasible. Said referendum also set forth the boundaries of the district as defined by the State Committee.

Now, Therefore, I, JOSEPH L. DONOVAN, Secretary of State of the State of Minnesote, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, do hereby find, after examination of the application and attempt referred to above, that the name proposed for said

district is not identical with that of any other soil conservation district of the state or so nearly similar as to lead to confusion or uncertainty; and

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I, JUSERE L. BOHOVAH, Secretary of State, do, therefore, hereby certify that the Aitkin County Soil Conservation District has been duly organized and constitutes a governmental sub-division of this State and a public body, corporate and politic, vested with all of the powers conferred upon such districts by low.

Statement by the State Soil Conservation Committee

TO ALL TO THOM THESE PROPERTIES SMALL COME, CREETINGS:

Be it known that on the 25th day of January, 1957, a petition for the organization of the Aitkin County Soil Conservation District, signed by more than twenty-five land occupiers was duly filed in the office of the State Soil Conservation Committee;

That on the 27th day of February, 1957, at Aitkin, a public hearing was held after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

That on the 25th day of March, 1957, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory and did define the boundaries thereof;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Conmittee on the question of the creation of the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the defined boundaries on the 20th day of April, 1957;

That the result of the referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the said referendum were in favor of the creation of the said district;

That thereafter on the 35th day of A ril, 1957, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that the operation of the said district is administratively practicable and feasible;

That the boundaries of the said district were defined by the State Soil Conservation Committee as Pollows:

All of the County of Aitkin, Lünnesota

There shall be exempted from the area bounded by the above described boundaries all lands used exclusively for religious, school or burial purposes; all parts and parcels of lands in cities, towns and villages which lands are used principally for residential purposes or for business purposes other than farming; all lands in rural or urban areas of ten acres or less; and all lands of five acres or less which are used exclusively for woodlot purposes.
