A Proclamation for National Safe Boating Week

WHEREAS, Minnesota has been blessed by nature with more than 13,000 beautiful lakes and countless other waterways; and

WHEREAS, each year thousands of Minnesotans, together with our out of town visitors, find pleasure and enjoyment through using these lakes for fishing, swimming, and boating; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that we use our lakes and waterways in such a manner as to take care that no tragedies result from carelessness or recklessness; and

WHEREAS, the United States Coast Guard is sponsoring an observance of National Safe Boating Week to call to the attention of the boating public, the proper way in which to use water equipment to insure pleasure and safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 18 through July 6, 1957, as

NATIONAL SAFE BOATING WEEK

and urge all Minnesotans to cooperate.
