A vacancy having occurred in the office of the Revisor of Statutes due to the resignation of the Honorable Edwin L. Kennedy;

Pursuant to the provisions of c. 482 H. S. directing the Supreme Court of said state to appoint to the office of Revisor of Statutes a person qualified to perform the duties of such office, and the court having determined that Joseph J. Bright of St. Paul, Minnesota, is so qualified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That the said Joseph J. Bright do, and he hereby is appointed Revisor of Statutes of the State of Minnesota with all of the powers and subject to the duties specified in said act. Pursuant to c. 920, L. 1937, Sec. 15, the salary of said Revisor of Statutes is hereby set at \$12,000 per annum.

This order shall take effect July 1, 1937 and continue until the further order of this court.
