
WE THE JUDGES ORGANIZED, That the said Joseph J. Bright do, and he hereby is appointed Revisor of Statutes of the State of Minnesota with all of the powers and subject to the duties specified in said act. Pursuant to c. 930, L. 1907, Sec. 10, the salary of said Revisor of Statutes is hereby set at \$12,000 per annum.

This order shall take effect July 1, 1907 and continue until the further order of this court.
