

ORDINANCE NO. 155

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS
AND INCORPORATE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY THEREIN

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS DOES ORDAIN:

Section 15:04. Village Boundaries Extended. Pursuant to a petition
duly signed by all of the owners of the land contiguous to the existing
boundary of the Village of Sauk Rapids and described as follows:

That certain real estate situate in the County of Benton, State of
Minnesota, to-wit, that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest
Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township Thirty-six (36)
North, Range Thirty-one (31) West, to-wit:- Beginning at a point on the
North line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ in said Sec. 23-36-31, Thirty-three (33) feet
East of the Northwest corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ - Thence running East along
said North line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ for One Hundred Seventy (170.0) feet:-
Thence due South and parallel with the West line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ for a
distance of One Hundred (100.0) feet:- Thence due West and parallel with
the North line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ for a distance of One Hundred Seventy
(170.0) feet:- Thence due North for One Hundred (100.0) feet to the point
of beginning and there terminating, said tract containing 40/100 acres
(more or less).

Also that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter
(SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Thirty-six (36) North,
Range Thirty-one (31) West described as follows, to wit, beginning at a
point on the South line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ thirty-three (33) feet east of
the Southwest corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, thence running North for Three
Hundred Fifteen (315.0) feet along the east line of the Township Road:-
Thence running East and parallel with said south line for a distance of
One Hundred Seventy (170.0) feet:- Thence running south parallel with said
road for a distance of Three Hundred Fifteen (315.0) feet:- Thence running
West along said south line for a distance of One Hundred Seventy (170.0)
feet to the place of beginning, and containing One and 23/100 acres (more
or less) and which is platted as "Larson's 2nd Addition". The territorial
limits of the village are hereby extended to include such land within its
limits, which shall hereafter be governed as other territory of the village
is governed.

Section 15:05. Copies to be Filed. The Village Clerk shall forward
a certified copy of this ordinance to the secretary of State and to the
County Auditor for Benton County, Minnesota.

Section 15:06. Effect. Such land shall be annexed upon the filing
of the certified copies hereof with the secretary of state and the County
Auditor.
