

EXTRACT OF MINUTES OF
MEETING OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL
OF THE VILLAGE OF
KASSON, MINNESOTA

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Kasson, Minnesota, was held at the Council Chambers in said Village on Wednesday June 12, 1957, at 3:30 o'clock P.M., with the following members present:

Peterson, Hanson, Blaisdell, Lauden & Tietje
and none were absent.

The Clerk then presented a petition for the annexation of the lands, described in the ordinance hereinafter contained, to the Village of Kasson. Said petition was examined, approved and ordered filed. Member Tietje then introduced the following ordinance and moved its adoption:

ORDINANCE NO. 413

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE
VILLAGE OF KASSON

Whereas a certain Petition dated May 17, 1957 requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the Council on the 5th day of June, 1957; and

Whereas it is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the Village and is so subjected to the Village government; and

Whereas the property described below is unplatted property and does not exceed two hundred acres; and

Whereas the Petition is signed by all of the owners of land proposed to be annexed; Now Therefore,

The Village Council of Kasson ordains:

Section 1 - The corporate limits of the Village of Kasson are hereby extended to include the following described territory situate in the County of Dodge, State of Minnesota:

1. The West one hundred forty (140) feet beginning at the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹) of Section twenty eight (28), Township one hundred seven (107) North, Range Sixteen (16) West, thence East Ninety (90) rods, thence North Thirty (30) rods, thence West ninety (90) rods, thence South Thirty (30) rods to place of beginning containing 16 7/8 acres more or less;

and

The West One Hundred Forty (140) feet commencing thirty (30) rods North of the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹) of Section Twenty eight (28), Township one hundred seven (107) North, Range Sixteen (16) West, thence East Eighty (80) rods, thence North twenty four (24) rods, thence West Forty Eight (48) rods, thence South Nine (9) rods, thence West Twelve (12) rods, thence South Eleven (11) rods, thence West twenty (20) rods, thence South four (4) rods to place of beginning,

and

2. The West One Hundred Fifteen (115) feet of the property described as commencing at a point thirty four (34) rods North of the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹) of Section twenty eight (28), Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Sixteen (16) West, thence East twenty (20) rods, thence North Eleven (11) rods, thence East Twelve (12) rods, thence North nine (9) rods, thence West Thirty two (32) rods, thence South Twenty (20) rods to place of beginning,

and

3. The West four hundred (400) feet to the North One Hundred (100) acres of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹) of Section twenty eight (28), Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Sixteen (16) West, except one quarter of an acre in the Northwest corner described as follows:

Beginning thirty three (33) feet South and Thirty three (33) feet East of the Northwes corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE¹) of Section twenty eight (28), Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Sixteen (16) West, thence East

One Hundred Four and 36/100 (104.36) feet, thence
South one hundred four and 36/100 (104.36) feet, thence
West one hundred four and 36/100 (104.36) feet, thence
North one hundred four and 36/100 (104.36) feet,
excepting highway right of way,

and

4. Commencing at the Southwest Corner of the Northeast Quarter
(NE^{1/4}) of Section Twenty Eight (28), Township One Hundred Seven
(107) North, Range Sixteen (16) West, thence East Four Hundred
Feet, thence North One Hundred Fifty (150) feet, thence West
Four Hundred (400) feet, thence South One Hundred Fifty (150)
feet to place of beginning, excepting highway right of way.

Section 2 - That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to file
a copy of ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in the
Office of the Auditor of Dodge County, Minnesota.

Section 3 - This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
