


IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE

ORDER


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, in pursuance of the law aforesaid, do hereby order and direct the retirement of Lee R. Rohrer as Judge of the Probate Court of Dodge County of the State of Minnesota, and I direct that this order be filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota on the 2nd day of July, 1957, at which time, under the authority of the statute aforesaid, the office of the Judge of Probate Court of Dodge County of the State of Minnesota, now held by the Honorable Lee R. Rohrer, will become vacant.
