NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1957, as


"CO-OP MONTH"

and urge an understanding and recognition of the achievements and services of cooperatives in Minnesota, and of the constructive and responsible role they share in economic progress under our system of free enterprise.


