

On this third day of September, A. D. 1914, Governor Eberhart duly issued and caused to be filed in the Executive Department of the State of Minnesota his proclamation as follows:

WHEREAS, It has been made to satisfactorily appear to me that on Wednesday morning, August 13th, 1914, one Jules Pieton, ~~xxxxxxx~~ was murdered by party or parties unknown at his home near Browerville, Todd County; and

WHEREAS, Every effort has been made to arrest the guilty party or parties, but without success, and the public safety requires his or their capture, conviction and punishment for said offense;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Adolph O. Eberhart, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the treasury of said State the sum of THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.) for the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator or perpetrators of said crime, or for such information as will lead to the aforesaid arrest and conviction.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State to be hereto affixed, at the Capitol in the City of St Paul, this third day of September, A. D. 1914.
