A PROCLAMATION FOR SIGHT-SAVING MONTH

WHEREAS, good sight is one of man's most precious treasures, and

WHEREAS, human sight, once lost, cannot be regained, and

WHEREAS, human sight is constantly threatened by disease, injury and neglect, and

WHEREAS, the National Society for the Prevention of Blindness has set aside September 1957 as "Sight-Saving Month"

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 1957 as

SIGHT-SAVING MONTH

in Minnesota and do urge all citizens of the state to join with the National Society for the Prevention of Blindness in its observance.
