

MOTOR VEHICLE RECIPROcity AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE STATE OF MINNESOTA AND THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA

The duly authorized officials of the State of Minnesota and the State of Oklahoma acting by and through the authority granted to them by the law of their respective states, hereby agree to reciprocally waive payment of all motor vehicle registration or license plate taxes or fees for vehicles owned by Minnesota residents and properly and lawfully registered in Minnesota when operating into or through the State of Oklahoma; and to reciprocally waive payment of such taxes and fees for such vehicles owned by Oklahoma residents and properly and lawfully registered in Oklahoma when operating into or through Minnesota under and subject to the following conditions and limitations:

I

Private passenger automobiles and trailers or house trailers attached thereto are entitled to full reciprocity for a period of sixty (60) days provided the owner does not engage in a gainful occupation while temporarily residing in the reciprocating state.

II

Reciprocity privileges shall not extend to commercial vehicles, including trucks, buses, truck-tractors, trailers and semi-trailers, while being operated in intrastate commerce.

III

Nothing contained in this agreement shall be construed to authorize the operation of motor vehicles upon the highways of either of the states in excess of the maximum weight, length, width or height allowed by the laws of such state in which such vehicle is being operated.

IV

Nothing contained in this agreement shall be construed to apply to regulatory laws, rules or regulations of the respective states under their respective statutes for common and contract carriers as administered by the Minnesota Railroad and Warehouse Commission and a like body in the State of Oklahoma.

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V

Each of the contracting parties of each state shall cooperate with each other and hereby agree to furnish such aid and assistance to the other as may be within their statutory authority as will aid in the proper enforcement of this agreement, and to carry out the purposes of their legislative acts pursuant to which this agreement has been made.

VI

This agreement became effective April 28, 1955, and shall continue in full force thereafter until modified or cancelled by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice; and provided further that it shall remain at all times subject to any alterations or modifications which may be made by legislative enactment in either state.

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The signatory states hereto have caused to be affixed the signatures of the responsible official or officials of each state acting pursuant to the authority conferred on such official or officials by the laws of the state which he or they represent this 28th day of April, 1955.
