MAYER VILLAGE ORDINANCE NO. 29

An ordinance extending the corporate limits of the Village of Mayer to include certain platted or unplatted land not exceeding 200 acres in area.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated May 13, 1957, requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the council on the 14th day of May, 1957;

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE.

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYER ORDAINS:

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Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. Were to Address.

The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

Tract 1. Beginning at a point on the West line of Hauters second addition to Mayer Village, said County and State, 33 feet South of the Northwest corner thereof; thence North along said West line and extension thereof 100 feet; thence West and parallel to the Westerly extension of the North line of said addition, 183 feet; thence South and parallel to the West line of said addition, 183 feet; thence East and parallel to the point of beginning.

Excepting any rights the public may have over the Easterly 33 feet thereof. Lying and being in the Northeast Quarter of Section 1 Township 116 North Range 25 West and containing 42 acre, more or less.

Tract 2. The tract thus described being in Waconia Township and located on the Northern outskirts of the Village of Mayer, said Carver County, Minnesota, and containing \$50,100 acre of land, more or less.

Section 4. Effective Unite of Anmexation. Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in section 3.
