

ORDINANCE NO. 49.

AN ORDINANCE AFFECTING THE VILLAGE OF ST. ANTHONY COUNTY MINNESOTA,
LAWES IN MARSH COUNTY.

WHEREAS a petition requesting annexation to the Village of
St. Anthony of certain additional lands in Ramsey County has been presented
to and filed with the Village, which lands are so described herein below
and wherein said petition has been made and signed by a majority of the
owners of said lands and said lands are unpopulated and do not exceed in their
total area the sum of 230 acres; and notice of said proposed annexation has
been posted according to law for a period of at least thirty (30) days; and
a public hearing has been held by the Council on the proposed annexation
and it being that said lands are suburban in character and abut upon the Village
of St. Anthony, and are not included in any other village, or in any city or
borough and are so considered as properly to be subjected to village government;
and said lands have a natural connection, as well as a unity of interest with
this village, and annexation of said land by the village is deemed to be in
the best interest of the village out of said lands,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ST. ANTHONY DO ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1955, Sec. 412.041, there is
hereby annexed, attached to and made a part of the Village of
St. Anthony that land lying in the County of Ramsey, which abuts the village on
the North boundary limits (the corner Map of Leckovitch Drive, in Ramsey County)
and to the north of the center line of Leckovitch Drive, East of Stinson
Boulevard, and West of Silver Lake Road, and extending generally northerly from
said Leckovitch Drive to the body of water known as Silver Lake, said lands and
premises being lands in Ramsey County legally described as:

"The Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of
Section Thirteenth (13), Township Thirty (30), Range Twenty-Four (24),
except the North 590 feet, and except the South 595 feet of
the North 2125 feet of the West 721 feet thereof, and also, that
part of the North half of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of
Section 31, Township 30, Range 23, lying northerly of Leckovitch Drive,¹
all according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after
180 publication.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed upon publica-
tion of this ordinance to file a certified copy hereof in the
office of the County Auditor in and for the County of Ramsey, and also, to
file a certified copy hereof in the office of the Secretary of State of the
State of Minnesota.

Section 4. That upon such publication and the filing of a certified copy of
this ordinance in the office of the County Auditor, and in the
office of the Secretary of State the annexation shall be complete and the land
herein above described shall become a part of the Village of St. Anthony, as
affectional as if it had been originally a part of said village.
