NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 11, 1957, as


AMERICAN YUGOSLAV DAY

and urge all citizens of Minnesota to recognize the contributions made to our state by Americans of Yugoslav descent.


