Section 3: The Village Council of Floodwood, Minneseta, on the basis of the findings and determinations therein made hereby annexes and declares that the hereinafter described premises to be annexed to the Village of Floodwood, which premises consists of a tract of land situated in the County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota, described as follows to wit:

Section 4. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the County, Minnesota.

Section 5. Effective Date of this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be complete and effective from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as described in Section 4.
