ORDINANCE NO. 7

A AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING,
P RATIFYING AND APPROV-
ING ANNEXATION OF CER-
TAIN LAND BY THE VIL-
LAGE OF MAPLE PLAIN.

WHEREAS, under date of October 10, 1956, the Village Council of Maple Plain, Minnesota, unanimously passed and entered upon its minutes Ordinance No. 48 annexing to said Village of Maple Plain certain land owned by said Village upon which is its municipal sewage disposal plant, which land is situated in Hennepin County, Minnesota, and described as follows, viz:

The South Two (2) rods of the North Fifty (50) rods of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), except road, and the South One Hundred Sixty-seven (167) feet of the East Five Hundred (500) feet of the North Forty-eight (48) rods of the said Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), except road, all in Section Twenty-five (25), Township One Hundred Eighteen (118), Range Twenty-four (24) West, according to U.S. Government survey thereof, and

WHEREAS, under date of November 1, 1956, an election was held in Independence Township at which election a majority of its voters voted to incorporate as a Village, and

WHEREAS, the former Township of Independence is now duly incorporated and functions as the Village of Independence, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the respective Village Councils of Independence and Maple Plain to clarify the status of the above described premises with particular reference to said premises now being within the corporate limits of the Village of Maple Plain and in order to avoid future troubles and disputes from arising between said Villages.

The Council of the Village of Independence ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below is properly within the corporate limits of the Village of Maple Plain.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Maple Plain were properly extended to include the territory lying and being in the County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, described as follows, viz:

The South Two (2) rods of the North Fifty (50) rods of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), except road, and the South One Hundred Sixty-seven (167) feet of the East Five Hundred (500) feet of the North Forty-eight (48) rods of the said Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$), except road, all in Section Twenty-five (25), Township One Hundred Eighteen (118), Range Twenty-four (24) according to U.S. Government survey thereof.

Section 3. Approval. The annexation of the above described property by the Village of Maple Plain, and all proceedings in connection therewith are, and the same is hereby in all respect ratified, confirmed and approved.

Section 4. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the County Auditor of Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Section 5. Effective Date of this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be complete and effective from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as described in Section 4.
