## ORDINANCE NO. 37

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE
OF LANESBORO, MINNESOTA

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LAWESBORD DO ORDAIN:

That J. A. Connelly, the owner of an unplatted tract of land of approximatly seven acres in size, within the Village Lanesboro on the Southwest part thereof, having petitioned and asked the Village Council that such seven acre unplatted tract be detached from the corporate limits of the Village of Langsboro, it is hereby ordained that from and after the date of filing of a certified copy of this ordinance with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, that said seven acre unplatted tract shall be detached from the corporate limits of the Village of Lanesboro, and the Village boundries are hereby limited to exclude the said seven acre unplatted tract of land, described as follows; to-wit; "Beginning at the Morthwest corner of the Northeast Quarter (NEA) of the Southwest Quarter (SWA) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township One Hundred Three North (103N) Range Ten West (10W), Fillmore County, Minnesota, thence South 25th rods to South bank of Mill Pond, thence Southeasterly following south bank of Mill Pond to center of U. S. Highway No. 16, thence Northeasterly following center of highway to a point 44 rods East and 15 rods South of the North West corner of the North Wast Quarter (NEX) of the South West Cuarter (SWA) of Section (24) Twenty-four, Township One Hundred Three North (103N) Range Ten West (10W), thence Worth 15 rods to the North line of the North East Quarter (NEL) of the South West Quarter (SWa), thence West 44 rods to place of beginning, containing about seven acres more or less according to the U.S. Government survey thereof ".
