

EXTRACT OF MINUTES OF

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Kasson, Minnesota, was held at the Council Chambers in said Village on Wednesday, ~~June 12~~<sup>July 2</sup>, 1957, at 3:30 o'clock P.M., with the following members present:

Peterson, Hanson, Blaisdell, Landon & Tietje  
and none were absent.

The Clerk then presented a petition for the annexation of the lands, described in the ordinance hereinafter contained, to the Village of Kasson. Said petition was examined, approved and ordered filed. Member Tietje then introduced the following ordinance and moved its adoption:

ORDINANCE NO. 1214

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS  
OF THE  
VILLAGE OF KASSON

Whereas a certain Petition dated May 13, 1957 requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the Council on the 9th day of June, 1957; and

Whereas it is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the Village and is so subjected to the Village Government; and

Whereas the property described below is unincorporated property and does not exceed two hundred acres; and

Whereas the Petition is signed by all of the owners of land proposed to be annexed; Now Therefore,

The Village Council of Kasson ordains:

Section 1 - The corporate limits of the Village of Kasson are hereby extended to include the following described territory situate in the County of Dodge, State of Minnesota:

Commencing at a point fifty nine (59) feet West of the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section twenty eight (28), Township One Hundred Seven (107) North, Range Sixteen (16) West, thence North along the right of Way of Highway #57 a distance of 1764.33 feet, thence West 180 feet, thence South 1764.33 feet, thence East 180 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2 - That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in the Office of the Auditor of Dodge County, Minnesota.

Section 3 - This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 37

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE  
OF LANESBORO, MINNESOTA

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LANESBORO DO ORDAIN:

That J. A. Connelly, the owner of an unplatted tract of land of approximately seven acres in size, within the Village of Lanesboro on the Southwest part thereof, having petitioned and asked the Village Council that such seven acre unplatted tract be detached from the corporate limits of the Village of Lanesboro, it is hereby ordained that from and after the date of filing of a certified copy of this ordinance with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, that said seven acre unplatted tract shall be detached from the corporate limits of the Village of Lanesboro, and the Village boundaries are hereby limited to exclude the said seven acre unplatted tract of land, described as follows; to-wit; "Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township One Hundred Three North (103N) Range Ten West (10W), Fillmore County, Minnesota, thence South 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  rods to South bank of Mill Pond, thence Southeasterly following south bank of Mill Pond to center of U. S. Highway No. 16, thence Northeasterly following center of highway to a point 44 rods East and 15 rods South of the North West corner of the North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section (24) Twenty-four, Township One Hundred Three North (103N) Range Ten West (10W), thence North 15 rods to the North line of the North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South West Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), thence West 44 rods to place of beginning, containing about seven acres more or less according to the U.S. Government survey thereof".
