A PROCLAMATION FOR AMERICAN EDUCATION WEEK

WHEREAS, true faith in education must be shown by work on its behalf in every community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 10-16, 1957 as

in Minnesota and do urge all citizens and organizations to acquaint themselves with the achievements and problems of their own schools, toward the end that the schools will receive the encouragement and support that they need.
