NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning October 6, 1957 as

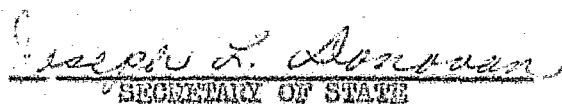
FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

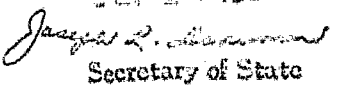
in Minnesota and call upon the citizens of this state to promote programs for the control and prevention of fire.
