

ORDINANCE NUMBER 15.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF LITTLEFORK.

The Village Council of the Village of Littlefork do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described lands, abutting upon the incorporated Village of Littlefork, be and the same are hereby annexed to said Village and shall become a part of such Village as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof: All of Government lot one, in Section ten, in township sixty-eight North of Range twenty-five West of the 4th P. M., except those parts described as follows: Commencing at a point thirty-three feet south and thirty-three feet east of the northwest corner of said Government lot one; thence east forty-six rods eleven feet and two inches; thence south thirty-four rods five feet and six inches; thence west forty-six rods eleven feet two inches; thence north thirty-four rods five feet six inches to point of beginning. Also that tract commencing in the northeast corner of said Government lot one, and running west sixteen rods; thence south twenty rods; thence ~~East twenty rods~~ East sixteen rods; thence north twenty rods to point of beginning.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be of force and effect from and after its publication, filing with the Auditor of Koochiching County, and filing with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
