

AN ORDINANCE  
ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS  
TO THE VILLAGE OF STEWARTVILLE

WHEREAS, a Petition of Annexation of Lots Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Sixty-seven (67), and Sixty-eight (68) of Wooldridges Second Highland Addition to the Village of Stewartville, was presented to the Village Council on July 24th, 1957, and whereas 30 days posted notice and two weeks published notice of the Hearing on the Proposed Annexation was had, and the hearing on the proposed annexation was held September 3, 1957, at 7:30 P. M. in the Chambers of the Village Council

AND WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Stewartville and the territory affected.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF STEWARTVILLE, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Lots Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Sixty-seven (67) and Sixty-eight (68) of Wooldridge's Second Highland Addition to the Village of Stewartville, are hereby annexed to and made a part thereof of the Village of Stewartville.
2. The Village Clerk is hereby instructed to file a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the County Auditor and one in the office of the Secretary of State.
