A PROCLAMATION FOR MINNESOTA VEGETABLE WEEK

WHEREAS, vegetable canning and freezing is one of Minnesota's most important industries; and

WHEREAS, it employs upwards of 20,000 Minnesota citizens, who receive more than 15,000,000 dollars in wages each year; and

WHEREAS, it utilizes about 150,000 acres of Minnesota land and supplies income for many farmers; and

WHEREAS, the value of the vegetable canning and freezing industry to the state is in excess of \$50,000,000, of which about \$35,000,000 comes into Minnesota from outside the state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 14-21, 1957 as

MINNESOTA VEGETABLE WEEK

and remind all citizens of the state of the value of the vegetable canning and freezing industry to Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-seven and of the state, the one-hundredth.
